Maintenance of the codes

DIGEST

This is the annual maintenance of the codes bill.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE LAW

COMMENTS

1. Commitment to delete any substantive provision

A condition for inclusion in the annual code maintenance bill is that the change must be nonsubstantive. Consequently, any provision that is identified as making a substantive change will be deleted by the Office of Legislative Counsel.

2. <u>"All-purpose" yielding clause avoids double jointing problems</u>

Proposed Section 235 on pages 714-715 of this bill includes an "all purpose" yielding clause that avoids any double jointing problems that might otherwise occur.
