

3.	SB 1065	Eggman	California Abandoned and Derelict Commercial Vessel Program. The amendments, as proposed in the analysis, would require notice before a commercial vessel can be removed, specify how a seized or removed vessels is handled after seizure or removal, and make other technical changes.
4.	SB 1182	Eggman	Family law. The amendments, as proposed in the analysis, would clarify the procedure by which a self-identified veteran may file a form with the family court setting forth their veteran status, and clarify the obligations of the court and the Department of Veterans Affairs when such a form is filed.
8.	SB 1342	Bates	Aging multidisciplinary personnel teams. The amendments, as proposed in the analysis, would require informed consent before information can be shared, the ability to opt out of the sharing of information at any time, and that notice of these rights be provided.
11.	SB 1210	Cortese	Personal rights: obscene materials: attorney's fees.
14.	SB 1092	Hurtado	Developmental services: individual program plan: fair hearings. The amendments, as proposed in the analysis, would make mediation mandatory if requested by either party, and remove the prohibition on a regional center from hiring, retaining, or employing an attorney unless the claimant is also represented by an attorney who appears on their behalf.
21.	SB 1001	Min	California Cybersecurity Integration Center: consumer protection: credit reporting.

28.	SB 1398	Gonzalez	Vehicles: consumer notices.
29.	SB 1254	Hertzberg	Drinking water: administrator: managerial and other services. The amendments, as proposed in the analysis, would clarify the scope of the liability provisions.
30.	SB 1214	Jones	Planning and zoning: local planning. The amendments, as proposed in the analysis, would make it clear that the site plan or a massing diagram has to be submitted at the time when an official copy of architectural drawings are submitted to a local planning agency, and not afterwards, and would fix a typographical error.
