<i>The proposed amendments on pages 11-13 of the analysis would clarify that, in addition to foreign governments, foreign state-controlled enterprises would be prohibited from newly acquiring agricultural land in California. The amendments also eliminate the reporting requirements for agricultural land owners and, instead, direct the California Department of Food and Agriculture to use existing data sources to produce an annual assessment of the impact that trends in foreign ownership of agricultural land, water rights, desalination facilities, and energy supply may have on California's food security.</i> |

| 11. | SB 1300 | Durazo | Foster youth: Supplemental Security Income.
<i>The proposed amendments on pages 9-11, comment 3 of the analysis are minor technical amendments to ensure that the statute's use of "nonminor dependent" is consistent throughout, to clarify a county's obligation with respect to foster youth under the supervision of a tribal organization, and to make nonsubstantive conforming changes.</i> |

<i>The proposed amendments on page 10, comment 4 of the analysis would cap both the 703 and 704 exemptions for accrued vacation pay, sick pay, and wages at a total of \$7,500.</i>
