<i>The proposed amendments would clarify and contain the scope of the bill's remote deposition provisions. Amendment 1 would remove a provision stating that any person may take or attend a deposition remotely, because the language could be interpreted to allow deponents to elect to appear remotely; it further adds that, at the election of the deposing party or the deponent, the deposition officer may appear remotely. Amendment 2 would clarify that the right of other participants to attend a deposition in person---even where the deposition officer is appearing remotely---remains subject to the right to seek a protective order under Code of Civil Procedure section 2025.420. Amendment 3 would add a subdivision clarifying that the provisions allowing the deposition officer to attend remotely do not alter any of the other time, place, and manner requirements regarding depositions.</i> |

<i>The proposed amendment would clarify the provision intended to prevent courts from charging a filing fee for trustee declarations of nonmonetary status. Specifically, the amendment directly states that no filing fee may be charged, so there will be no confusion in clerks' offices about the impact of the new subdivision.</i> |
